
Figure 1. Program of the WOP-P Master (120 ECTS credits)







The WOP-P Master has an insurance policy in compliance with the requirements of the Erasmus+ programme for Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees.






A contribution to student participation costs

A contribution to student travel and installation costs

A subsistence allowance for the entire duration of the study period

5. STUDENTS: Applications \rightarrow The EMJMD student scholarship





1. Participation costs: up to EUR 4,500 per academic year per scholarship holder

2. Travel costs: EUR 1,000 per academic year.

3. Subsistence costs: EUR 1,000 per month for the entire duration of the study period (24 months maximum)

Contribution to subsistence costs will neither be given to the scholarship holders for the EMJMD periods spent in their country of residence.

MORE SPECIFIC DETAILS HERE

1. Participation costs: up to EUR 9,000 per academic year per scholarship holder

2. Travel and installation costs:

- Scholarship holder residing in a Partner Country city located at less than 4,000km from the Coordinating University (University of Valencia):

- Travel costs: EUR 2,000 per academic year.
- Installation costs: a single payment of EUR 1,000 to cover the entire study period.

- Scholarship holder residing in a Partner Country city located at 4,000km or more from the Coordinating University (University of Valencia):

- Travel costs: EUR 3,000 per academic year.
- Installation costs: a single payment of EUR 1,000 to cover the entire study period.

3. Subsistence costs: EUR 1,000 per month for the entire duration of the study period (24 months maximum)

Contribution to subsistence costs will neither be given to the scholarship holders for the EMJMD periods spent in their country of residence nor to scholarship holders from a Partner Country for the EMJMD periods spent in any Partner country exceeding one trimester.

5. STUDENTS: Applications \rightarrow The EMJMD student scholarship



- Students who have already obtained an EMJMD scholarship or an Erasmus Mundus Master Course/Joint Doctorate scholarship are not eligible to apply for an additional scholarship under the EMJMD action
- EMJMD scholarship holder cannot benefit from another EU funded scholarship scheme to follow the same EMJMD course, and this for the entire period of the course

Be aware that the consequences in case of false declarations would force the student to reimburse scholarships unduly paid.

Students' personal data will be sent to the EACEA at the European Comission and may be used by other bodies involved in the management of EMJMD acting as stakeholders of the programme (i.e., European Commission, Erasmus+ National Offices, EU Delegations, Erasmus Mundus Students and Alumni Association) to facilitate student access to the joint programme. For any given academic year, the number of applications for an EMJMD scholarship to any of the Erasmus+ Erasmus Mundus must be limited to maximum three different joint programmes. 5. STUDENTS: Selection process



Due to the complexity of the selection process, different steps of the selection process will be taken in parallel. Thus, interviewing candidates does not guarantee that they fulfil all compulsory requirements (e.g., the validity of the diploma).

The Coordinating Committee will decide on the <u>Mobility scheme</u> of students. Their decision will be based on student preferences; a balance among partner institutions, and student fluency in the programme languages (English, Portuguese, and Spanish).

5. STUDENTS: Selection process → <u>Admission and evaluation criteria</u>

The compulsory admission criteria are:

- A Degree in Psychology (i.e., Bachelor of 3, 4 or 5 years)
- A full-time commitment to the two-year programme and, for granted students, further commitments as required by the scholarship conditions
- Fluency in English (Level B2 under the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).
